Every club may choose its own way of determining its Club Champions.

For example, a club could

- nominate the pair that won its own championship pairs competition.
- choose to hold a special pairs event to decide who will represent it.
- choose the pair that has performed best over a series of club evenings.
- use some other form of competition that seems best for your club.

All your club secretary needs to do is inform the WBU Tournament Organiser, Simon Gottschalk, nto@welshbridgeunion.org of the names of the two players who will represent the club (no later than 1st June 2024). Table money, including lunch buffet is £60 per pair. Clubs are asked to consider sponsoring their Champions' cost of representing them in this event.

Only WBU members are eligible to play in the Champions of Champions.

It may be that the champion pair in your club competition is not available to play on 23rd June. In that case, the club may nominate the next highest-ranking pair to play in their place. Similarly, if a club's champion pair have already qualified to play as the champions of another club, the next highest-ranking pair may play as representatives of your club.
